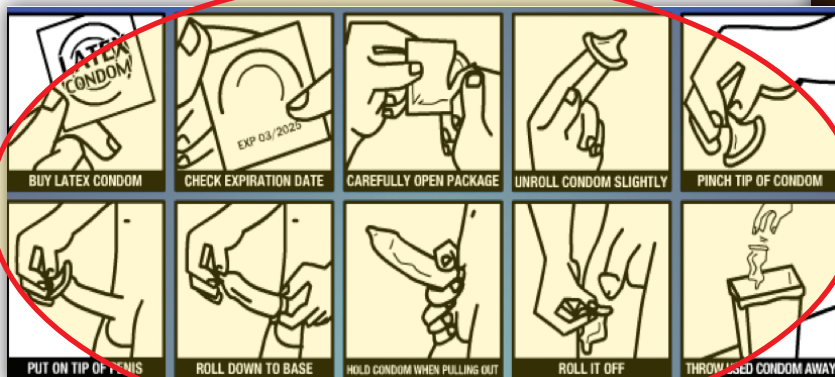
"You just need to do it, and then you'll realize sex is no big deal."
